1	Leader In Me Kickoff	Students learn the 7 Habits and participate in various activities that stress the importance of each habit. The week is to introduce the students to the 7 Habits.	August 30-September 2, 2021
2	Saudi National Day	Students participated in different events to encourage them to take pride in their culture and history. The students completed posted and dressed in traditional dress. Grade 12 students prepared a presentation and booth for the MoE event.	September 19-21, 2021
3	Grade 12 Homeroom Recycling	Grade 12 student started a homeroom-recycling project and supplied recycling boxes to the classroom.	September 2021 and on-going
4	School-wide Recycling Program	Grade 12 students expanded their recycling program to the entire school. The students contacted a recycling company for the school to purchase recycling bins for different areas of the building.	September 2021 and on-going
5	Classroom Job Responsibilities	Students are assigned various jobs and must maintain certain standards in order to retain the job or be assigned to it, again, in the future. Jobs include: Line Leader (front and back), Board Eraser, Teacher's Helper, Board Information (Attendance, Lesson Information, Homework), Sound Control, Bathroom Login Chart, Project and Lights Controller, Paper/Notes Distributor, Messenger, PowerPoint/Computer Scroller, Quote of the Day, Homework Checker, Worksheet Collector.	September 2021 and on-going
6	Breast Cancer Awareness	Students attended a session on Breast Cancer Awareness. Students and staff also wore pink in support of the even for the month of October.	October 4, 2021 and ongoing
7	Classroom Job System	Students rotate jobs on a weekly basis. Jobs include titles such as Line Manager, Assistant Teacher, Board Assistant, Tech Assistant, etc. The job system allows students to grow in their leadership capacity and to learn what it is to be a responsible citizen by taking care of their job for the week.	October and ongoing
8	Mental Health Day	Activities helped to raise mental health awareness. Students were guided in various ways to reduce stress.	October 10, 2021
9	Recycling Day	Teachers planned various activities that inspired their students with the power of recycling.	October 28,2021
10	Learning Acceleration	Learning Acceleration Program using the support of high school student volunteers to accelerate the learning of Grade 1 students who missed kindergarten due to the pandemic.	October - November 2021
11	Diabetes Day	Students learned the warning signs of diabetes and the importance of maintaining a healthy diet and exercising. The students also learned the contributing factors of diabetes, how diabetes is treated, and how to measure blood sugar levels.	November 7, 2021
12	International STEAM Day	In honor of International STEAM Day, students studied the biography of Greta Thunberg and her significant role in raising global awareness of climate change issues. The curriculum was adapted to address climate change across three subject areas (English, Science, and Social Studies). Students shared ways they could contribute to the reduction in emissions by using fewer aerosol-based products, switching off lights, unplugging electrical appliances, and by encouraging parents to avoid having motor vehicles idling when stationary. Students also monitored the La Palma volcanic eruption in the Canary Islands and discussed various possible solutions.	November 8, 2021
13	Career Day	Students choose a career and dress in the appropriate clothes for the career. The students also make presentations about the career and the general work requirements for the career.	November 16, 2021
14	Kindness Day	Teachers spoke about kindness inside and outside the classroom to help students cultivate compassion and empathy for others and develop safe, caring, and respectful school communities where students thrive. Grades 1-4 created posters and presented them in the hallway.	November 18,2021
15	Multicultural Day	Students learned the definition of multiculturalism and how different cultures have contributed to the global society. Each homeroom focused on one culture and presented the information to their peers.	November 21, 2021

16	Friendship Day	Students shared stories about the importance of friendship and being kind to others. Students also designed posters and participated in small group discussions.	November 25, 2021
17	Reduce Your Carbon Footprints	Students calculated their carbon footprints on the scale provided by the World Health Organization. Students then developed ways in which they can reduce their Carbon footprint at school, at home, and on weekends/vacation. Students created doodle art on a footprint template to showcase their innovative solutions.	November 2021
18	Power Hour Peer Tutoring	Under the supervision of their teachers, students serve as peer tutors 3 or 4 times per week during the lunchtime Power Hour. Other students served as tutors after school to earn NHS hours.	November 2021 and ongoing
19	Tips for Keeping Bullies Away	Posters, activities, and discussions helped to raise awareness about cyberbullying and other types of bullying. Students were provided with different ways to prevent bullying and how to report an issue	November 2021 and ongoing
20	World Children's Day	Activities raised awareness of children's rights.	November 2021 and ongoing
21	Human Rights Day	Human Rights Day inspired students to speak up and take action to end discrimination in all of its forms whenever and wherever it happens. Students participated in various activities that helped them to identify the right way to tackle human rights violations.	December 16, 2021
22	International Day of Persons with Disabilities	Strong Participation at an event in Panorama Mall	December 10, 2021
23	Green Day	The main objective of celebrating this day was to create awareness about protecting the earth. Teachers planned activities to raise awareness about preserving the natural resources. Students were also encouraged to participate in making the earth a better place to live.	December 30, 2021
24	Do-It-Yourself (DIY) Recycled Paper	In Science class, students prepared recycled paper using scrap paper collected at school. Students used their recycled paper as an alternative to construction paper for arts and crafts projects.	December 2021
25	Make Every Day Earth Day	Students contacted recycling companies and have started a student-driven, on-campus recycling program.	December 2021
26	Social and Emotional Skills (SEL)	As part of a STEAM focus activity, students learned about SEL skills that are important to working in teams and staying healthy.	December 2021
27	Riyadh Pollution Blog	Computer Science students demonstrated their social responsibility by writing a blog about the cause, effect, and proposed solutions to pollution.	January 2022 and ongoing
28	School Cleanup Project	Grade 12 students wrote proposals for a school-wide initiative to keep the school clean. Components included --Not writing on school property --Cleaning personal trash off tables and desks --Having weekly cleanup helpers in each classroom --Maintain recycling efforts. Students felt that it also would be a good way to develop teamwork skills, model socially responsible behavior to younger students, help with communication skills, and help the environment. 29	Raising Awareness About Pollution in the Community	Students collaborated to create multi-media presentations to raise awareness about air and water pollution and their solutions	January-February 2022
30	School Safety Day	Students will learn the information for Civil Defense and what they can do to keep others safe. The students will learn the basics of CPR and how to recognize if someone is choking.	March 8, 2022
31	Dr. Seuss Day	Students learn the importance of reading and how reading helps them become a global citizen. The students will bring their favorite book and dress up as a character from the work of literature.	March 31, 2022
