














































H1 2025 Investor Update

Total revenue until 30th June 2025 amounts to SR 583 million, compared to 30th June 2024 amounts to SR 536 million, with increase of SR 46 million (9% Increase)

Net Profit until 30th June 2025 amounts to SR 13.8 million, compared to the Net Profit until 30th June 2024 amounts to SR 71.4 million. The significant variance is due to the onetime sublease agreement of the educational property during the Q1 2024.

The forecasted Net Profit for FY2025 is 70 Million -(for shareholder only).








Q2 2025 Income Statement








Q2 2025 Sector Break-up


